



Procedure: Practice Pick-Up / Communication

1. SUMMARY

1.1. The following policy and procedure address the responsibilities of parents/guardians regarding practices including: parent pick-up and parent communication.

2. COACHES TIME:

2.1. Keep in mind that all coaches are volunteers and be respectful of their time. In addition to being responsible for conducting practices, coaches spend many additional hours attending required board meetings and preparing for games.

3. PROCEDURE:

3.1. All athletes are expected to attend all scheduled practices. If unable to attend due to illness or other conflict it is requested that a parent notify the head coach as soon as possible.

3.2. Parents or guardians are expected to report to practice at the appropriate location a minimum of ten minutes before the scheduled end of practice. Although information is often disseminated electronically, the end of practice is also an excellent time in which information can be shared as well.

3.3. In the event a player is left at practice beyond the anticipated time; the coach(s) will remain with the player and immediately contact the parents/guardians listed on the emergency form.

3.4. At the Coaches' discretion, he or she may transport players when asked to do so by a player's parent.

3.4.1. No coach at any time is permitted by the SWYBB organization to drive an athlete home by him/herself without previous arrangements with a player's parent.

3.5. If a parent does not arrive within 10 minutes beyond the scheduled end of practice, the local police will be contacted and requested to drop off the athlete at the address provided.
